INTRODUCTION

Under Activity 3.3.2 of Sub-Component 3.3, a first version of an improved set of criteria for the selection of UWUAs for obtaining technical credit for the procurement of maintenance machinery and equipment was drafted by the Chief Advisor Component 3 in collaboration with the national on-farm MOM expert. Following a review by the CSU and PIU, a final version of the UWUA selection criteria was prepared and submitted to the World Bank for review and no objection.

2 **AGREED UWUA SELECTION CRITERIA**

The agreed criteria for the selection of UWUAs for obtaining technical credit required for the procurement of maintenance machinery and equipment are as follows:
